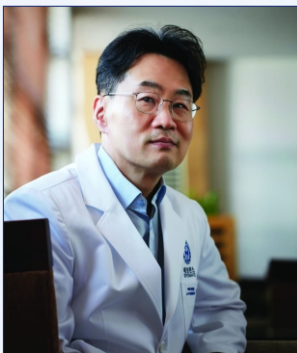

PLACES TO VISIT IN CHH. SAMBHAJINAGAR

Ajanta Caves:



The Ajanta Caves are 31 rock-cut cave monuments which date from the 2nd century BC. The caves include paintings and sculptures considered to be masterpieces of both Buddhist religious art (which depict the Jataka tales)[8] as well as frescoes which are reminiscent of the Sigiriya paintings in Sri Lanka.[9]

Ellora Caves

Declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Ellora Caves are considered to be one of the world's largest rock-cut caves. Constructed between 600 and 1000 CE, the Ellora Caves consist of 100 Hindu, Jain, and Buddhist caves, out of which 34 are open to visitors.



Bibi-ka-Maqbara



Bibi Ka Maqbara in Chh. Sambhajinagar is a 17th-century Mughal mausoleum built by Prince Azam Shah for his mother, Dilras Banu Begum. Often called the "Mini Taj Mahal" or "Deccan ka Taj" for its striking resemblance to the Taj Mahal, it serves as a significant, albeit smaller, replica of the famous monument.

Ghrishneshwar Temple



Considered the Earth's 12th Jyotirlinga, the Ghrishneshwar Temple is one of the top historical places in Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar for Hindu devotees. Exhibiting prehistoric architecture, the temple flaunts a 5-tier shikara, beautiful sculptures, and intricate ancient carvings.

Devgiri Fort

Constructed back in the 12th century, the robust Devgiri Fort is considered to be a very powerful fortification of the medieval era. Perched atop a conical hill at an elevation of 200 meters from sea level, this fort posed to be a real challenge to defeat. This fort had multiple layers of strong defense walls and could only be accessed by a slender bridge.



Bhadra Maruti



Dedicated to the Hindu god Lord Hanuman, Bhadra Maruti is one of the three temples of the country where the god can be seen in a sleeping position. According to popular beliefs the ruler of Khultabad was called Bhadravati and the king was devoted to Lord Rama.

Shirdi, located in Maharashtra, is a famous pilgrimage town known as the home of Saint Sai Baba. Devotees from across India and the world visit the Shirdi Sai Baba Temple to seek blessings and experience spiritual peace.
